Guest Speaker: Fern G.Z. Carr was introduced by Brian Street

Fern, who taught in SD#23 for 14 years before her retirement, is a contemporary Canadian poet with an international reputation. She composes and translates poetry in six different languages – including Mandarin and has work published in 34 countries.

Fern illustrated her philosophy – and literary skill – by referring to poems from her published book 'Shards of Crystal' which she explained is a metamorphosis from darkness to light. It initially deals with dark subjects such as: suicide, dementia, cruelty to animals and gradually changes course to move to the beauty of life with poems of spiritual liberation and the philosophy of existence. From the pain of 'Shards' the poems slowly transform to the beauty and enlightenment of 'Crystal'. The book culminates with Fern's poem 'I Am' which examines man's place in the universe.

Fern was thanked for her informative, emotional and thought-provoking presentation. Attendees were able to purchase 'Shards of Crystal' and were given the opportunity to ask questions and react to Fern's poems at greater depth following her presentation.
